

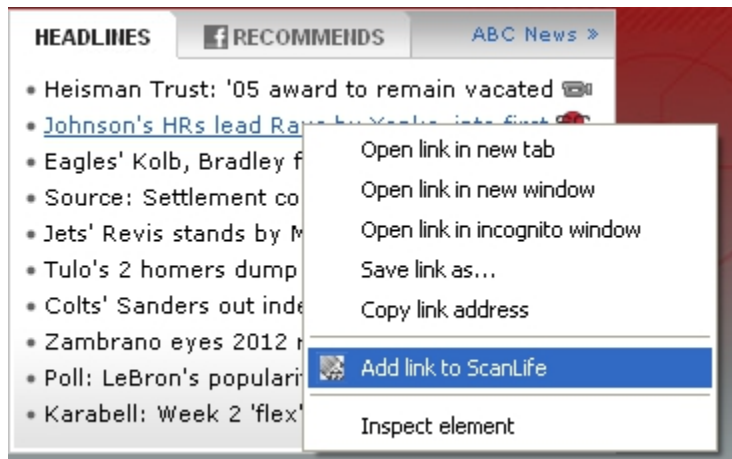
ScanLife Browser Extension

2D barcodes, or QR Codes, have become a popular way to easily link physical objects to digital content. Now, you can create a 2D code from anywhere on the web in a couple clicks using the ScanLife browser extension.

Why use the extension?

The extension works for the same reason why many people use tool bars instead of actual websites (i.e. searching through the Google tool bar instead of google.com). The internet is becoming faster and more “on demand” centric by the day, so this makes it faster than ever to create, display and download 2D barcodes (QR code, EZcode, and Datamatrix) from any page, URL link, or image.

While the extension is fast, it also can also link your codes to an existing [ScanLife](#) account. If you link the two, you can edit your codes at a later time, or get analytics from the scans if you have a Business account (number of scans, users, location, etc).






Possible Uses:

- Want to save a great photo to your phone? Just create a code from your favorite photos on Facebook, Flickr, etc. to download images onto your phone.
- Place your digital “badge” on places like your resume, email signature, t-shirts and more. Just go to your Facebook or Twitter page and create a code.
- Quickly create a code from Google Maps to take contact information or directions to a new restaurant or store.
- For business use, you can create codes in bulk without logging into your ScanLife account. This may make it easier to create a bunch of codes in a short period of time.

Tip: Remember to use mobile formatted content whenever possible! Just place an “m” before common domains like Facebook or YouTube to get the mobile version.

How to Download:

To download the ScanLife Browser Extension, select a link below for your preferred browser:



How to Use:

To create a web code of a current page, simply click on the “add to ScanLife” button located on the toolbar.

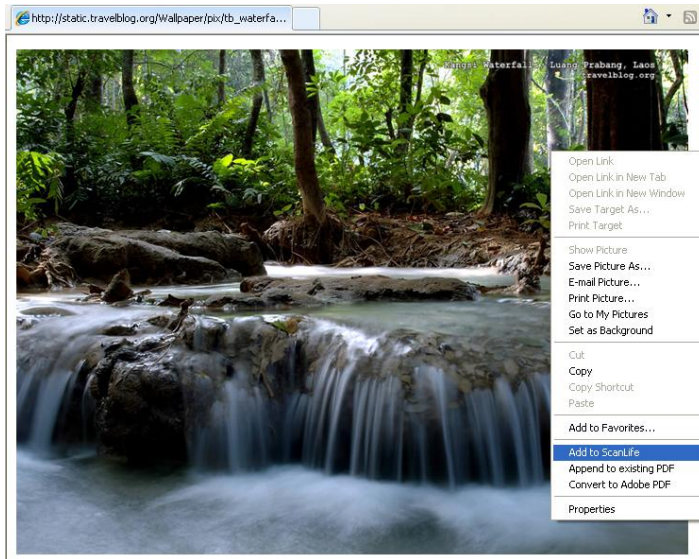
Your code will instantly appear in the top right corner of your screen along with the barcode information (URL, name and title) and the download option. **You can choose from three different formats like QR Code, EZcode, and Datamatrix.**

Within seconds, you can begin scanning!

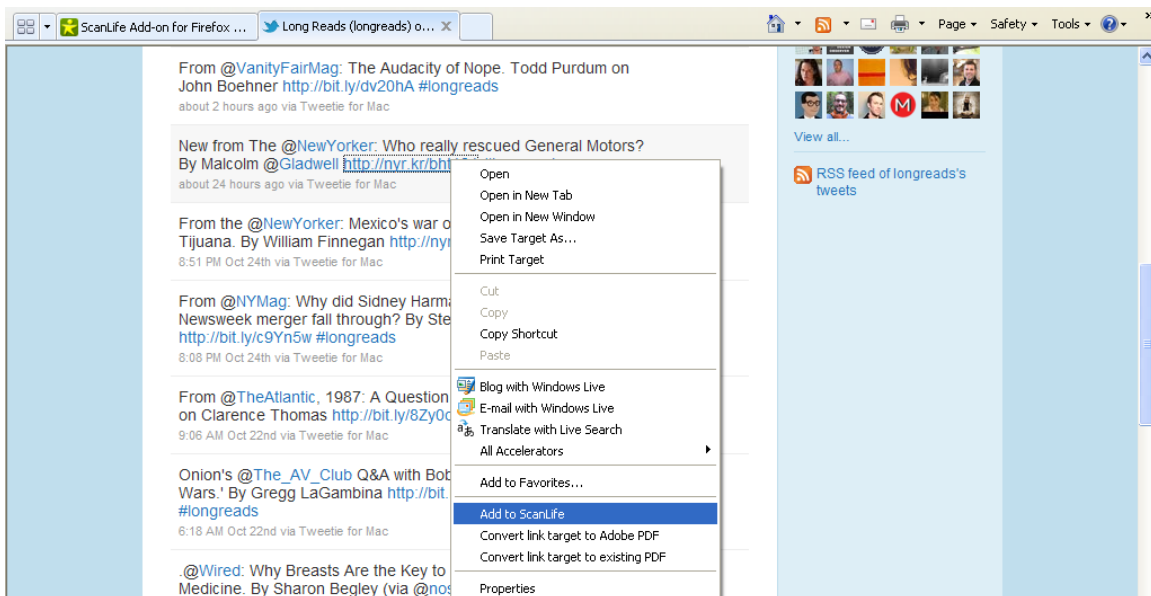
